A Combined Package for Young Adults for One Price

Young adults, ages 18-30, may attend both Justice Camp (in Hamilton) followed by Ask & Imagine (in London) for a TOTAL cost of \$700.00 (that's \$100.00 off each program) with transportation costs covered no matter where you are coming from in Canada. Spaces are limited for this subsidized option, so apply early. Complete separate applications for each program, and indicate on both that you are applying for the *young adult joint program*. Regular deposit for Justice Camp must be included with that application (no deposit required for Ask & Imagine).
